

Intermountain Health Epic Haiku, Canto and Rover Mobile App Setup Guide

Please follow the steps below to access Epic Mobile Apps Haiku, Canto or Rover. NOTE: Typically, Haiku is the only Epic mobile app needed by most users. *Use the other apps only when specifically directed by Intermountain personnel.*

Haiku (For Apple iPhone and Android smartphones)

1. If you don't already have the Epic Haiku app on your phone, go to the Apple App Store or the Android Play Store and download/install the Epic Haiku app. Then, minimize or close the app.

2a. If you have this guide open on a device other than your phone: Open your phone's Camera App and scan the QR code below and select the URL shown in the camera app:



2b. If you have this guide open on your phone, paste this URL into a browser e.g. Safari or Chrome:

Canto (For Apple iPad tablets)

1. If you don't already have the Epic Canto app on your iPad, go to the Apple App Store and download/install the Epic Canto app. Then, minimize or close the app.

2a. If you have this guide open on a device other than your phone: Open your iPad's Camera App and scan the QR code below and select the URL shown in the camera app:



2b. If you have this guide open on your iPad, paste this URL into a browser e.g. Safari or Chrome:

Rover **Public** Access (For Apple iPhone and Android smartphones)
