



What is changing/or what needs to be communicated?

A new blood product ordering PowerPlan titled **Blood Products: Surgical Standby (order pre-admit)** has been created. There is a adult and pediatric version of this PowerPlan.

 Blood Products: Procedural Standby (order pre-admit) - ADULT

 Blood Products: Procedural Standby (order pre-admit) - PED

This new plan will replace the *Blood Products: Make Available* PowerPlan for scheduled procedures. Providers will need to **Remove** their **Blood Products: Make Available** PowerPlan and **ADD** the **Blood Products: Surgical Standby (order preadmit)** PowerPlan to their Plan Favorites Folders.

Surgery Schedulers who propose orders to their providers will now **select Blood Products: Surgical Standby (order preadmit)** instead of Blood Products: Make Available PowerPlan.

Why it's changing?

This PowerPlan will help resolve identified issues with the ordering of Blood Product PowerPlans for patients coming into the hospital for surgical procedures.

Since this PowerPlan does not expire for 6 months, it can be placed in advance at the same time other future procedural orders are placed in the patient's chart, thus simplifying pre-ordering blood in advance.

Who will it impact?

Schedulers/Providers placing surgical blood product orders on patients coming into the hospital for surgery.
